The health benefit policy, contract or agreement of the 3 2. 4 individual provides for payment or reimbursement of the service. 5 When a patient has signed an assignment of benefits agreement with a provider, the carrier shall reimburse the provider 6 7 directly. B. As used in this section, "advanced pharmacist services" 8 9 means providing patient assessment, interpreting drug-therapy 10 related tests and participating in education and evaluation of 11 disease state management and complex medication regimens by a Doctor 12 of Pharmacy with one of the following board certifications from the 13 Board of Pharmacy Specialties: ambulatory care, cardiology, critical 14 care, compound sterile preparation, geriatric, infectious disease, 15 nutrition support, nuclear, oncology, pediatric, psychiatric, 16 pharmacotherapy and solid organ transplantation. 17 SECTION 2.
