17	A. A charter school sponsored as provided for in Section 3-132
18	of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes and a virtual charter school
19	sponsored by the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board pursuant to
20	Section 3-145.3 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be
21	prohibited from using their State Aid allocation or any other state-
22	appropriated revenue to advertise or to contract with an individual
23	or business entity to provide advertising services.

1 B. For the purposes of this section, "advertise" and 2 "advertising" mean an attempt by written, electronic or graphic 3 representation to elicit enrollment or the sale of goods or 4 services. The terms include, without limitation, such 5 representations made: 6 1. On signs, displays, circulars, brochures, menus of services 7 and recruitment materials; and 8 2. On the Internet, through the press, radio or television, or by use of any other medium. 10 C. The State Board of Education and the Statewide Virtual 11 Charter School Board shall promulgate rules necessary to implement 12 the provisions of this section. 13 SECTION 2.
