13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 500 of Title 4, unless there is
15	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. Except as otherwise provided in subsection B of this
17	section, the owner or custodian of a domestic dog shall cause the
18	animal to be vaccinated against rabies by the time the animal is
19	four (4) months of age and at regular intervals thereafter according
20	to the label directions of an approved rabies vaccine for use in
21	that species, or as prescribed by ordinances or rules adopted by a
22	municipality within whose jurisdiction the animal owner resides.
23	B. A veterinarian, in his or her sole professional discretion,

may delay rabies vaccination for a domestic dog if the veterinarian
