14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18-114.15 of Title 70, unless
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. Beginning with the 2020-2021 school year, a school district
19	board of education shall not enter into a new contract or renew a
20	contract with a superintendent after July 1, 2020, that exceeds the
21	maximum compensation amounts provided for in the following schedule:
22	1. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
23	average daily membership (ADM) of one hundred fifty (150) or less,
24	the salary for the lowest-salaried teacher in the district with an

1 education degree and amount of experience that is equal to the 2 degree and experience held by the superintendent multiplied by one 3 and four-tenths (1.4);

4 2. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
5 ADM of two hundred fifty (250) or less but more than one hundred
6 fifty (150), the salary for the lowest-salaried teacher in the
7 district with an education degree and amount of experience that is
8 equal to the degree and experience held by the superintendent
9 multiplied by one and five-tenths (1.5);

3. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an ADM of five hundred (500) or less but more than two hundred fifty (250), the salary for the lowest-salaried teacher in the district with an education degree and amount of experience that is equal to the degree and experience held by the superintendent multiplied by one and seven-tenths (1.7);

4. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an ADM of one thousand (1,000) or less but more than five hundred (500), the salary for the lowest-salaried teacher in the district with an education degree and amount of experience that is equal to the degree and experience held by the superintendent multiplied by two (2);

5. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an ADM of two thousand five hundred (2,500) or less but more than one thousand (1,000), the salary for the lowest-salaried teacher in the

1 district with an education degree and amount of experience that is 2 equal to the degree and experience held by the superintendent 3 multiplied by two and three-tenths (2.3);

6. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
ADM of five thousand (5,000) or less but more than two thousand five
hundred (2,500), the salary for the lowest-salaried teacher in the
district with an education degree and amount of experience that is
equal to the degree and experience held by the superintendent
multiplied by two and five-tenths (2.5);

For the superintendent of a district or districts with an 11 ADM of ten thousand (10,000) or less but more than five thousand 12 (5,000), the salary for the lowest-salaried teacher in the district 13 with an education degree and amount of experience that is equal to 14 the degree and experience held by the superintendent multiplied by 15 two and eight-tenths (2.8);

16 8. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an 17 ADM of fifteen thousand (15,000) or less but more than ten thousand 18 (10,000), the salary for the lowest-salaried teacher in the district 19 with an education degree and amount of experience that is equal to 20 the degree and experience held by the superintendent multiplied by 21 three and one-tenth (3.1);

9. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
ADM of twenty thousand (20,000) or less but more than fifteen
thousand (15,000), the salary for the lowest-salaried teacher in the

1 district with an education degree and amount of experience that is 2 equal to the degree and experience held by the superintendent 3 multiplied by three and four-tenths (3.4);

4 10. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
5 ADM of thirty thousand (30,000) or less but more than twenty
6 thousand (20,000), the salary for the lowest-salaried teacher in the
7 district with an education degree and amount of experience that is
8 equal to the degree and experience held by the superintendent
9 multiplied by three and nine-tenths (3.9); and

10 11. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an 11 ADM of more than thirty thousand (30,000), the salary for the 12 lowest-salaried teacher in the district with an education degree and 13 amount of experience that is equal to the degree and experience held 14 by the superintendent multiplied by four and three-tenths (4.3).

B. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules
necessary to implement the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
