14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-116.5 of Title 70, unless
16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	On or before October 31, 2020, the Commission for Educational
18	Quality and Accountability shall issue a report to the Speaker of
19	the House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the
20	Oklahoma State Senate and the Governor detailing factors in
21	Oklahoma's public education system that contribute to:
22	1. Improvements in the common education system, including, but
23	not limited to, high school graduation rates and college and career
24	assessment scores.

2. Improvements in the higher education and CareerTech systems, including, but not limited to, timely graduation rates and reduced remediation rates; and

- 3. Improvements in the state's workforce, including, but not limited to, career readiness and the ability for new graduates to find in-state employment.
- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-116.6 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Should the Commission find there is insufficient information available to fulfill any of the report objectives specified in Section 1 of this act, the report shall also contain recommendations on ways to address information gaps between state entities such as the State Department of Education, the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education and the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-116.7 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Commission may contract with a private consultant or consultants to assist with the development of the report.

SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-116.8 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
