7 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Resolution proclaiming certain counties in
9 southeastern Oklahoma to be the home of Oklahoma's
10 treasured rivers and lakes.

12 WHEREAS, the scarcity of water in the western states has been an
13 issue since the first peoples came to inhabit the region; and

14 WHEREAS, areas with an abundance of water resources are vital to
15 those regions' wildlife, vegetation growth, natural beauty, tourism
16 and to the populations of people that live in those areas; and

17 WHEREAS, with the convergence of numerous rivers, creeks and
18 streams and its many water reservoirs, the Choctaw Nation in
19 southeastern Oklahoma contains more water than any other region in
20 this state; and

21 WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation in southeastern Oklahoma is
22 comprised of these eleven (11) counties: Atoka, Bryan, Choctaw,
23 Coal, Haskell, Hughes, Latimer, Leflore, McCurtain, Pittsburg and
24 Pushmataha.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
2 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 57TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

3 THAT the eleven (11) counties of the Choctaw Nation are hereby
4 proclaimed by the Oklahoma House of Representatives as the home of
5 Oklahoma's treasured rivers and lakes.
