17	data, our nation currently has 250,000 unsolved murders, a number
18	that increases by about 6,000 each year; and
19	WHEREAS, Unsolved cases mean mounting caseloads for law
20	enforcement, which drain resources and result in higher costs for
21	agencies with limited budgets; and
22	WHEREAS, victims and families and friends of victims of violent
23	crimes suffer great anguish that is increased by the fact that the
24	crimes remain unsolved; and
