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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicle registration;
8 amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1112, as last amended
9 by Section 1, Chapter 325, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
10 2019, Section 1112), which relates to application for
11 registration; permitting registrant to add emergency
12 contact information to application for specified
13 purpose; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1112, as
16 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 325, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
17 2019, Section 1112), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1112. A. Every owner of a vehicle possessing a
19 certificate of title shall, before using the same in this state,
20 make an application for the registration of such vehicle with a
21 motor license agent. The application shall contain such information
22 as shall be required by the Oklahoma Tax Commission. Every owner,
23 when making application for registration, shall furnish the
24 following information:

1 1. A full description of the vehicle including the make, model,
2 color, manufacturer's serial or other identification number, any
3 security interest upon the vehicle, an odometer reading of the
4 vehicle when applicable, and the insurance security verification to
5 the vehicle;

6 2. The correct name and address, the name of the city, county
7 and state in which the person in whose name the vehicle is to be
8 registered resides, the driver license number of the owner if the
9 owner has a driver license or the Federal Employers Identification
10 Number of the owner if such owner is not an individual, and such
11 other information as may be prescribed by the Commission; and

12 3. a. The name of the carrier of the owner's insurance
13 policy for such vehicle,

14 b. The policy number of the owner's policy for such
15 vehicle, if available, or the name of the agent or
16 office where the existence of security may be
17 verified, if other than the carrier,

18 c. The effective dates of the owner's policy for such
19 vehicle, and

20 d. A statement of the existence of a nonuse affidavit if
21 filed by the vehicle owner pursuant to the provisions
22 of Section 7-607 of this title.

1 B. Any owner or lessee of a noncommercial vehicle possessing a
2 certificate of title may, at the time of initial application for
3 registration or application for renewal, inform the Tax Commission:

4 1. That the owner, lessee or someone who may be operating the
5 vehicle is deaf, hard-of-hearing, autistic or suffers from Apraxia
6 or a communication disorder; and

7 2. Of any contact information for a person who may be notified
8 in case of an emergency affecting the owner or lessee. That
9 information, if provided, shall be available to law enforcement
10 through the Tax Commission's vehicle registration system to assist
11 law enforcement in identifying the operator of the vehicle as
12 possibly being deaf, hard-of-hearing, autistic or suffering from
13 Apraxia or a communication disorder, or in the case of an emergency,
14 in identifying an individual listed as an emergency contact. As
15 used in this section, "communication disorder" is defined as
16 impairment in the ability to receive, send, process and comprehend
17 concepts or verbal, nonverbal and graphic symbol systems.

18 C. In every case where a vehicle has been registered upon an
19 application containing any false statement of a fact required in
20 this section to be shown in an application for the registration
21 thereof, the Commission shall give written notice of at least five
22 (5) days to the owner of the vehicle, and shall require the owner to
23 appear before it for the purpose of showing cause why the
24 registration should not be canceled. Unless satisfactory

1 explanation is given by the owner concerning such false statement,
2 the Commission shall cancel the registration. The owner of the
3 vehicle shall then be required to immediately reregister the vehicle
4 and pay the required fees. The owner shall not be entitled to
5 refund or credit for the fees paid for registration of the motor
6 vehicle made under the application which contained any false
7 statement of fact.

8 D. The Commission shall insert in the application forms
9 appropriate notice to the applicant that any false statement of a
10 fact required to be shown in such application for registration
11 subjects the applicant to prosecution.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.

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
