AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Employment Security Administration Fund; making appropriation; specifying source; specifying programs and amount of appropriation; requiring expenditure by certain date; requiring certain federal standards; requiring compliance with Social Security Act; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Employment Security Administration Fund, out of funds made available to this state by the federal Unemployment Compensation Modernization Transfer made on June 25, 2009, pursuant to Section 903(f) of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C., Section 1103(f), as amended, the amount of Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) to be used by the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission for the purpose of paying the administrative expenses of the following programs in the following amounts:

1. The Employment Service program in the amount of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00); and

2. The Unemployment Insurance program in the amount of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00).

The funds appropriated by this section shall be expended on or before December 31, 2020. Expenditures from this appropriation shall be accounted for in accordance with standards established by the United States Secretary of Labor. The Oklahoma Employment Security Commission shall utilize the appropriation made by this section in accordance with the provisions and requirements contained in the Social Security Act, Title 42, of the United States Code.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
