AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring each school district board of education to coordinate with certain emergency medical services provider to develop certain plan prior to the beginning of certain school year; requiring plans to be reviewed and updated annually and placed on file with certain school district and certain emergency medical services provider; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 27-104 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. Prior to the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year, each school district board of education shall coordinate with the emergency medical services provider that serves the area in which the school district is located to develop a plan for the provision of emergency medical services at athletic events or activities held at school district facilities.

shall be reviewed and updated annually as appropriate and placed on file with the school district and the emergency medical services provider. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020. SECTION 3.
