SENATE BILL 1198

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring each school district board of education to coordinate with certain emergency medical services provider to develop certain plan prior to the beginning of certain school year; requiring plans to be reviewed and updated annually and placed on file with certain school district and certain emergency medical services provider; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 27-104 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Prior to the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year, each school district board of education shall coordinate with the emergency medical services provider that serves the area in which the school district is located to develop a plan for the provision of emergency medical services at athletic events or activities held at school district facilities.

1 B. The plan developed pursuant to subsection A of this section
2 shall be reviewed and updated annually as appropriate and placed on
3 file with the school district and the emergency medical services
4 provider.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
