SENATE BILL 1231

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to senior citizens; creating the Oklahoma Elderly Care Improvement Act of 2020; providing short title; directing the Department of Human Services to convene certain working group; providing for membership; requiring certain reports; providing for staff support; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1992 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Elderly Care Improvement Act of 2020".

B. The Department of Human Services shall convene a working group to study and make recommendations on ways to improve the care of senior citizens in Oklahoma. The working group shall consist of community organizations in Oklahoma dedicated to advancing the interests of senior citizens.

1 C. The Department shall report all findings and recommendations  
2 to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House  
3 of Representatives and the Governor. Additionally, the Department  
4 shall publish a report of the findings and recommendations on the  
5 Department's website.

6 D. Staff support shall be provided by the Department.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
