SENATE BILL 126

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Construction Industries Board;
prohibiting the requirement of certain licensed
number in certain types of advertisement; providing
for codification; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1000.8 of Title 59, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any law or rule relating to any trade,
occupation or profession regulated under Title 59 of the Oklahoma
Statutes, no person or entity possessing a valid license or
certification generated through the Construction Industries Board or
from any board, committee or commission operating under the
enforcement authority of the Construction Industries Board shall be
required to state or provide their state-issued license or
certification number in any electronic advertisement or any radio,

1 television, telephone message or other auditory-type advertisement
2 published in this state.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
