Every physician attending a pregnant woman in 17 Oklahoma during gestation shall, in the case of each woman so 18 attended, take or cause to be taken a sample of blood of such woman 19 at the time of first examination, and submit such sample to an 20 approved laboratory for a standard serological test for syphilis and 21 human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), unless the woman explicitly 22 declines. Every other person permitted by law to attend upon 23 pregnant women in the state but not permitted by law to take blood 24 tests shall cause a sample of the blood of such pregnant woman to be

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taken by a duly licensed physician, licensed to practice in the State of Oklahoma, and submitted to an approved laboratory for a standard serological test for syphilis and HIV, unless the woman explicitly declines. The term "approved laboratory" shall mean a laboratory approved for the purposes of this section by the State Commissioner of Health. A standard serological test for syphilis and HIV shall be one recognized as such by the Commissioner.
