SENATE BILL 136

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to statutes and reports; granting members of Legislature right to have certain number of measures receive committee hearing and vote; requiring written request; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 26.15 of Title 75, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

During each regular session, each member of the Senate shall have the right to have at least three bills or joint resolutions principally authored by such member and referred to a committee in the Senate receive a hearing in such committee, upon a written request to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate. During each regular session, each member of the House of Representatives shall have the right to have at least three bills or joint resolutions principally authored by such member and referred to a committee in the House of Representatives receive a hearing in such committee, upon a written request to the Speaker of the House of

1 Representatives. At such a hearing, any such bill or joint  
2 resolution shall receive a vote of the committee if a motion for  
3 such a vote is properly made and seconded according to the rules of  
4 that house of the Legislature.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
