21	time, providing frequently updated information to motorists;
22	2. The system is portable, allowing its installation, with
23	minor modifications as necessary, at different locations;

4. The system provides accurate and reliable information,
 keeping in mind the serious consequences of misinforming motorists
 in work zone situations.

B. The Department of Transportation is authorized to promulgate
any necessary rules to develop a smart work zone system. The
Department shall initiate at least two such systems before December
31, 2020.

10 C. The Department shall promulgate rules for contracting with 11 third parties who place or provide temporary traffic control devices 12 within or near construction zones. The rules shall require the 13 Department to pay a daily agreed-upon rate for the use or rental of 14 such temporary traffic control devices for each day the devices are 15 in use in a construction zone area.
