SENATE BILL 1523

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to hunting; allowing the use of feed blocks in public hunting areas; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-214 of Title 29, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Feed blocks of a size no greater than sixteen (16) inches wide and sixteen (16) inches tall shall be allowed on lands managed or owned by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation where public hunting is allowed.

B. For the purposes of this section, "feed block" shall mean a conglomeration of food, minerals or other edible products used to attract or supplement the diet of deer or other game.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
