6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motorcycles; amending 47 O.S.  
8 2011, Section 12-609, which relates to required  
9 equipment; modifying certain requirements; and  
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 12-609, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 12-609. A. In addition to other requirements  
15 prescribed by this chapter, by federal law or by local ordinance,  
16 all motorcycles, except when operated on actual trail rides  
17 conducted outside of public roads and highways, shall be equipped  
18 with:

19 1. Two rearview mirrors, containing a reflection surface of not  
20 less than three (3) inches in diameter, mounted one on each side of  
21 the motorcycle and positioned so as to enable the operator to  
22 clearly view the roadway to the rear of the vehicle;

23 2. A windshield of sufficient quality, size and thickness to  
24 protect the operator from foreign objects, except that in lieu of

1 such windshield, the operator shall wear goggles or other protective  
2 eyewear which meets American National Standards Institute (ANSI)  
3 Standard Z87.1 and provides positive retention, or a face shield of  
4 material and design to protect the operator from foreign objects;

5 3. A properly operating speedometer capable of registering at  
6 least the maximum legal speed limit for that motorcycle;

7 4. A fender over each wheel. All fenders shall be of the type  
8 provided by the manufacturer;

9 5. A horn which shall comply with the requirements of Section  
10 12-401 of this title; and

11 6. A muffler or other effective noise-suppressing system which  
12 shall comply with the requirements of Section 12-402 of this title.

13 B. No person ~~under eighteen (18) years of age~~ shall operate or  
14 ride upon any motorcycle unless such person is properly wearing a  
15 crash helmet of a type which complies with standards established by  
16 49 C.F.R., Section 571.218.

17 C. Handlebars on motorcycles shall not be higher than eye level  
18 of the operator.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
