SENATE BILL 1599

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crime and punishment; providing for definition; providing for certain offense; providing for certain penalty; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 858.4 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No teacher, as defined in Section 1-116 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be drunk or intoxicated while in the performance of their duties.

B. Every teacher, as defined in Section 1-116 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, who is convicted of a violation of this section shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not more than two (2) years, by a fine of not more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00), or by such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
