19	of fifteen (15) days for payment receipt after notice of payment
20	due. Such minimum time period shall be calculated from the date of
21	the actual mailing of the payment invoice, billing or statement
22	showing account balance or payment due. Notwithstanding any payment
23	due date printed on the customer's billing, invoice or statement,
24 27	the customer's payment shall not be deemed late or accessed late
