13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:				
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as				
15	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.				
16	2019, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:				
17	Section 1135.2. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby				
18	authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license				
19	plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as				
20	provided by this section.				
21	Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other				
22	person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of				
23	ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used				
24					

1 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
2 registered for the current year.

3 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 4 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 5 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. 6 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 7 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 8 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 9 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and 10 amateur radio operator license plates.

11 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 12 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 13 applications for special license plates authorized under this 14 The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's section. 15 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 16 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 17 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 18 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 19 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 20 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 21 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 22 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

B. The special license plates provided by this section are as follows:

Req. No. 3020

1 Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be 1. 2 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United 3 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war 4 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification 5 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war 6 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having 7 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving 8 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not 9 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 10 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war 11 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one 12 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 13 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 14 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 15 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

16 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be 17 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National 18 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide 19 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be 20 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide

1 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be 2 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

3 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed 4 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States 5 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry 6 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or 7 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member 8 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably 9 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying 10 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military 11 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or 12 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or 13 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof 14 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required 15 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

16 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such 17 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been 18 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply 19 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each 20 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 21 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse

1 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 2 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the 3 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon 4 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action 5 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse 6 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each 7 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in 8 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 9 of one (1) ton or less;

10 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be 11 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper 12 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs 13 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such 14 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration. 15 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate 16 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 17 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been 18 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not 19 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated 20 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one 21 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The 22 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee 23 provided by this section for special license plates;

1	8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be				
2	designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the				
3	United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of				
4	the United States as being:				
5	a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December				
6	7, 1941,				
7	b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of				
8	7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,				
9	the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to				
10	exceed three (3) miles, and				
11	c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United				
12	States Armed Forces.				
13	Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate				
14	for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or				
15	less;				
16	9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for				
17	any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States				
18	Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United				
19	States as being:				
20	a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February				
21	of 1945,				
22	b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate				
23	vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and				
24

a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
 States Armed Forces.

3 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each 4 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 5 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall 6 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and 7 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the 8 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB." 9 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such 10 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other 11 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the 12 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of 13 registration after the initial issue;

14 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be 15 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the 16 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of 17 the United States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
 19
 1944,
- b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
 participation cannot be verified by the United States
 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its

discretion, accept evidence of such participation from the person applying for the license plate, and c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United States Armed Forces.

Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

7 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be 8 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 9 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse 10 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 11 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action 12 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person 13 was killed in action and that the person making the application is 14 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse 15 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two 16 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) 17 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 18 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 19 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 20 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

21 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be 22 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 23 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply 24 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification

1 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making 2 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent 3 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two 4 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one 5 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 6 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 7 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 8 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

9 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be 10 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the 11 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the 12 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or 13 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a 14 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated 15 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

16 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 17 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United 18 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such 19 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each 20 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

21 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be 22 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal 23 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police 24 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and

1 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council 2 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may 3 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated 4 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of 5 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common 6 education police department by either an identification card or 7 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma 8 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for 9 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial 10 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of 11 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in 12 consultation with municipal police departments of this state; 13 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design 14 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in 15 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; 16 World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 16. 17 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 18 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 19 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of 20 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having 21 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from 22 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may 23 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a 24 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. _ _

1 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall 2 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia 3 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold 4 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps, 5 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which 6 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate 7 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at 8 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. 9 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words 10 "WORLD WAR II";

11 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 12 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 13 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 14 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of 15 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having 16 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June 17 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former 18 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for 19 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member

¹ belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the ² plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two ³ digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the ⁴ bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

⁵ 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only be produced upon application;

10 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be 11 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are 12 residents of this state. Such persons must present an 13 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a 14 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with 15 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend 16 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the 17 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and 18 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the 19 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red 20 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design 21 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other 22 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each 23 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

24

20. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

7 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be 8 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of 9 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may 10 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle 11 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

12 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates 13 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor 14 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in 15 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

16 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be 17 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air 18 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate 19 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 20 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license 21 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

22 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed 23 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for 24 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-

¹ Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with ² the Ninety-Nines;

3 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall 4 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge. 5 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend 6 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the 7 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge". 8 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate 9 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 10 less;

Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to members of the International Conference of Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

22 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
 23 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state

24

¹ who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the ² United States Secretary of Defense;

3 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be 4 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 5 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any 6 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as 7 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such 8 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying 9 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed 11 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate 12 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the 13 district number;

14 Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be 31. 15 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United 16 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the 17 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected 18 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which 19 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been 20 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a 21 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the 22 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability 23 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons 24 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license _ _

1 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no 2 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying 3 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any 4 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or 5 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or 6 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and 7 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans 8 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one 9 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The 10 fee provided by this section for the special license plate 11 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other 12 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees 13 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this 14 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

15 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate 16 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the 17 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be 18 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also 19 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized 20 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled 21 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the 22 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to 23 the Tax Commission;

 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
 designed in consultation with the Association;

6 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such 7 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state 8 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons 9 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for 10 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 11 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 12 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the 13 Academy;

14 Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall 34. 15 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's 16 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal 17 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor 18 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been 19 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment. 20 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle 21 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such 22 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax 23 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have 24 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call _ _

1 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications 2 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All 3 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on 4 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for 5 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee 6 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other 7 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant 8 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license 9 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio 10 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall 11 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any 12 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The 13 right to such special identification plates herein provided for 14 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the 15 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked; 16 35.

35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of membership. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of Oklahoma;

21 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be 22 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or 23 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for 24 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or

1 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county 2 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the 3 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which 4 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension. 5 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 6 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 7 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be 8 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this 9 state;

10 37. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates 11 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of 12 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran" 13 shall mean:

- 14 any person honorably discharged from any branch of the a. 15 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the 16 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result 17 of the performance of duties for any branch of the 18 United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard 19 while on active military duty, or 20 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
- 21 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the 22 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of 23 injury, illness or disease caused by the performance 24 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death

9 been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States
10 Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense
11 Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
12 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

39. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry. Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th Infantry;

40. Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in Operation Iraqi Freedom. Such person may apply for an Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle;
