SENATE BILL 1850

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the State Department of Health;
requiring Department to create and maintain certain
reporting and tracking system for specified purpose;
requiring Department to publish certain annual
report; specifying that act is subject to
restrictions under state or federal law; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-133 of Title 63, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

To the extent allowed under state or federal law including, but
not limited to, the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability
Act, the State Department of Health shall:

1. Create and maintain an automated reporting and tracking
system for health care practitioners and patients in this state to
report vaccine injuries and deaths. The purpose of the system shall
be to collect and analyze data on vaccine injury and death

1 statistics to establish whether long-term, chronic health risks
2 outweigh short-term, disease prevention; and

3 2. Compile the data annually into a report which shall be
4 published on the Department's website.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
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
