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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-133 of Title 63, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	To the extent allowed under state or federal law including, but
18	not limited to, the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability
19	Act, the State Department of Health shall:
20	1. Create and maintain an automated reporting and tracking
21	system for health care practitioners and patients in this state to
22	report vaccine injuries and deaths. The purpose of the system shall
23	be to collect and analyze data on vaccine injury and death
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1	statistics to establish whether long-term, chronic health risks
2	outweigh short-term, disease prevention; and
3	2. Compile the data annually into a report which shall be
4	published on the Department's website.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
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
