SENATE BILL 1860

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the state Medicaid program; directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to initiate certain requests for proposals; requiring pilot program to commence by certain date; specifying components of pilot program; providing certain requirements for accountable care organization; providing for promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5028.2 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall initiate requests for proposals for a pilot program to examine the feasibility of transforming the current Medicaid program from a fee-for-service payment model to a value-based payment model utilizing a provider-led accountable care organization. The pilot program shall begin no later than January 1, 2022.

1 B. The pilot program implemented by the accountable care
2 organization shall contain, but not be limited to, the following
3 components:

- 4 1. Value-based purchasing;
- 5 2. Quality measurements;
- 6 3. Data-sharing and integration;
- 7 4. Care management;
- 8 5. Provider and community collaboration; and
- 9 6. Preservation of the Supplemental Hospital Offset Payment
10 Program.

11 C. The accountable care organization shall be headquartered in
12 this state and shall be owned by a resident of this state.

13 D. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate
14 rules to implement the provisions of this act.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.

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
