AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to mental health and substance abuse services; providing for certain consent by certain minors; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-328 of Title 43A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a minor who is not less than sixteen (16) years of age or is emancipated may consent to outpatient mental health or substance abuse treatment, therapy, counseling or other services by a mental health or substance abuse services provider licensed in this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
