SENATE BILL 1897

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to hospitals; requiring hospitals to compile certain list; requiring the State Department of Health to develop certain lists and publish certain information; authorizing the Department to implement certain requirement; requiring hospitals to provide certain lists upon request; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-710.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Each hospital in this state shall compile a list of twenty-five common outpatient procedures and shall submit annually to the State Department of Health a list of its average charges for those procedures, in a method determined by the Department. The Department may develop a uniform reporting form for the purposes of this section and may require hospitals to file this completed form with the Department. The Department shall publish this information on its Internet website.

1 B. The Department shall establish a list of the twenty-five
2 most commonly performed inpatient procedures in hospitals in this
3 state, as grouped by Medicare diagnostic-related group. The
4 Department shall develop a list of each hospital's average charges
5 for those procedures, if applicable, and shall update the list at
6 least annually. The Department shall publish this information on
7 its Internet website.

8 C. Each hospital shall provide a copy of the lists described in
9 subsections A and B to any person upon request.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.

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
