SENATE BILL 260

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; prohibiting contracting for use of photo monitoring devices; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-226 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No state, county, municipal, or political subdivision may contract with any private corporation to provide for the use of any photo monitoring device to detect any red light violation.

B. As used in this section, the term "photo monitoring device" means a stationary, unmanned device used with a lighted traffic control device to detect a red light violation combined with a photographic identification of the vehicle which results in the issuance of a citation against the registrant, rather than the driver, of the vehicle.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
