6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to soldiers and sailors; amending
8 Section 1, Chapter 229, O.S.L. 2017, as amended by
9 Section 1, Chapter 387, O.S.L. 2017 (72 O.S. Supp.
10 2018, Section 421), which relates to the Oklahoma
11 Department of Veterans Affairs Registry; requiring
12 certain designation; modifying requirement for
13 certain information; modifying requirement for
14 promulgation of rules; modifying definition;
15 requiring the State Department of Health to provide
16 certain notification in certain circumstances;
17 providing for codification; and providing an
18 effective date.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 229, O.S.L.
21 2017, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 387, O.S.L. 2017 (72 O.S.
22 Supp. 2018, Section 421), is amended to read as follows:

23 Section 421. A. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs
24 shall create and maintain a registry of all veterans in this state
25 by January 1, 2020, which shall be titled the "Oklahoma Veterans
26 Registry". The registry shall include the following information
27 regarding the veteran:

28 1. Name;

1 2. Military ~~ranking~~ rank and branch of service;

2 3. Dates of service;

3 4. ~~Documentation of one hundred percent (100%) service-~~
4 ~~disability, if applicable~~ If a veteran enters any percentage of
5 service-connected disability, the Oklahoma Department of Veterans
6 Affairs staff shall confirm the claimed percentage with the United
7 States Department of Veterans Affairs; this will verify eligibility
8 of veterans claiming one hundred percent (100%) service-connected
9 disability for purposes of the sales tax exemption, as well as
10 generate statistical data on other levels of service-connected
11 disability among Oklahoma veterans; and

12 5. Date of death and place of burial, if applicable; and

13 6. Name of the veteran's spouse, if applicable.

14 B. As a component of the veterans registry created pursuant to
15 subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma Department of Veterans
16 Affairs shall designate those veterans within the registry as one
17 hundred percent (100%) service-disabled Oklahoma veterans, if
18 applicable. The registry designation shall also be maintained as a
19 separate list within the registry for all one hundred percent (100%)
20 service-disabled Oklahoma veterans. The Department shall be
21 responsible for verification of all information provided through the
22 registry and shall verify veteran service disability status at least
23 once every four (4) years.

1 C. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs ~~shall~~ may
2 promulgate rules for implementing the provisions of this section.

3 D. For purposes of this section, "veteran" means ~~a person who~~
4 ~~served on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States who~~
5 ~~was discharged or released with an honorable discharge~~ any person
6 who has served the full obligation for active duty, Reserve or
7 National Guard service in the military, or received an early
8 discharge for a medical condition, hardship or reduction in force
9 and has been separated or discharged from such service honorably or
10 under honorable conditions. For those veterans with a designation
11 of one hundred percent (100%) service-disabled, the veteran shall
12 have been assigned a disability percentage of one hundred percent
13 (100%) by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs.

14 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-317b of Title 63, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 For the purpose of updating the Oklahoma Veteran's Registry, the
18 State Department of Health shall notify the Oklahoma Department of
19 Veterans Affairs regarding the death of anyone it knows to be an
20 Oklahoma veteran.

21 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
