SENATE BILL 377

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads and bridges; amending 69 O.S. 2011, Section 1316, which relates to control of access; modifying the number of days required for certain notification of appointment; making certain report available electronically; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 1316, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1316. (a) Within ~~five (5)~~ seven (7) days after being notified of their appointment, the commissioners shall proceed to appraise and apportion the benefits to such lots and tracts of land, exclusive of streets and alleys, as are located within the assessment district, after having taken an oath to make a full and impartial apportionment. Any error in the description of a lot, parcel or tract of land liable for assessment shall not invalidate such assessment or lien thereof.

1 (b) The commissioners shall use as a guide the estimated  
2 assessments theretofore prepared by the engineer, but the estimates  
3 shall not be binding upon the commissioners.

4 (c) The commissioners shall have full and complete authority to  
5 vary the total assessment as between the various tracts, pieces and  
6 parcels of land, depending upon their nearness or remoteness to the  
7 facility, and nearness or remoteness to points of access to the  
8 limited access facility and any other factors that to the  
9 commissioners may appear as resulting in greater benefit to one such  
10 tract or parcel of ground than another.

11 (d) A written report of such apportionment shall be returned and  
12 filed with the city or county clerk, within fifteen (15) days from  
13 the date of the notice to them of their appointment. The report  
14 shall also be made available electronically to the Board of County  
15 Commissioners.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.

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
