The State Board of Health shall promulgate 18 rules that require all All medical and direct care staff of nursing 19 and specialized facilities, adult day care centers, assisted living 20 centers, hospice agencies and home health agencies licensed by the 21 State Department of Health to, and all workers trained in palliative 22 care shall complete, at a minimum, one (1) hour of in-service 23 training per year in Alzheimer's- and dementia-related care. 24
