The Oklahoma Tax Commission, Oklahoma 17 Department of Human Services and Oklahoma Employment Security 18 Commission shall be authorized to require agency employees and the 19 employees of agency contractors in positions that have access to 20 Federal Tax Information and data to supply all information and 21 documentation required in order to be subjected to a criminal 22 history search by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, as 23

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well as be fingerprinted for submission of the fingerprints through

the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to the Federal Bureau of

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    Investigation for a national criminal history check. The applicable
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    employer-agency submitting agency shall be the recipient of the
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    results of the record check. In accordance with Section 150.9 of
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    Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, this includes a national criminal
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    record with a fingerprint analysis.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
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
