AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to narcotic treatment programs;
amending 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-603, which relates
to medication fee for participation in opioid
substitution treatment program; deleting certain
approval requirement; granting opioid substitution
treatment program authority to assess certain fee;
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-603, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 3-603. A. ~~The Board of Mental Health and Substance~~
~~Abuse Services shall approve a standard~~ An opioid substitution
treatment program may assess a medication fee for persons
participating in an opioid substitution treatment program in an
amount determined by the program.

B. A person participating in an opioid substitution treatment
program shall be terminated from the program if the person fails to
participate in counseling sessions or if the person fails to adhere
to the program's guidelines as promulgated by the Board.

1 C. The Board is authorized to promulgate such rules as are
2 necessary to implement this act.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
