17	A. It shall be a delinquent act for a juvenile to:
18	1. Make a false report concerning an explosive or incendiary
19	device as defined in Section 1767.3 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
20	Statutes;
21	2. Perpetrate a hoax concerning an explosive or incendiary
22	device; or
23	3. Conspire to make a false report or perpetrate a hoax

1	B. Upon adjudication, the court having jurisdiction over an act
2	described in subsection A of this section shall refer the juvenile
3	to the Juvenile Bureau or the Office of Juvenile Affairs to
4	formulate a plan of rehabilitation. Such rehabilitation plan shall
5	be considered by the court at a dispositional hearing after notice
6	is given to all parties. The state and the juvenile shall have the
7	opportunity to be heard at the dispositional hearing. The court may
8	modify or adopt the plan after such notice and hearing.
9	Additionally, the court may impose restrictions upon or suspend the
10	juvenile's driving privileges.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
