AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to medical marijuana; setting certain restrictions on advertising; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 427 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All marijuana advertising and labels of usable marijuana and marijuana products sold in this state shall not contain any statement or illustration that:

1. Is false or misleading;
2. Promotes overconsumption;
3. Represents that the use of marijuana has curative or therapeutic effects; or
4. Depicts a child or other person under legal age to consume marijuana, or includes:

1 a. objects such as toys, cartoon or other characters,
2 which suggest the presence of a child, or any other
3 depiction designed in any manner to be especially
4 appealing to children or other persons under legal age
5 to consume marijuana, or

6 b. any manner or design that would be especially
7 appealing to children or other persons under eighteen
8 (18) years of age.

9 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
