6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
8 authorizing the State Board of Medical Licensure and
9 Supervision and the State Board of Osteopathic
10 Examiners to issue certain guidance; authorizing
11 Boards to take disciplinary action against certain
12 physicians; providing for codification; and declaring
13 an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 510.1 of Title 59, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision is
19 hereby authorized to issue guidance to all allopathic physicians in
20 this state on the recommending of medical marijuana to patients.

21 B. The Board may take disciplinary action as provided for in
22 the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and
23 Supervision Act against any allopathic physician who willfully
24 violates or aids another in the willful violation of the provisions
25 of Section 420 et seq. of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 638.1 of Title 59, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. The State Board of Osteopathic Examiners is hereby
5 authorized to issue guidance to all osteopathic physicians in this
6 state on the recommending of medical marijuana to patients.

7 B. The Board may take disciplinary action as provided for in
8 the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act against any osteopathic
9 physician who willfully violates or aids another in the willful
10 violation of the provisions of Section 420 et seq. of Title 63 of
11 the Oklahoma Statutes.

12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
