SENATE BILL NO. 764

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to medical marijuana; directing State Department of Health to create certain medical marijuana use registry; requiring certain compliance with federal law; specifying accessibility and purpose of registry; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 420.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Department of Health shall create a medical marijuana use registry for physicians, patients and caregivers. The handling of any records maintained in this registry shall be compliant with the provisions of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA).

B. The medical marijuana use registry shall:

1. Be accessible to Oklahoma physicians and medical marijuana dispensaries to verify the authorization of a licensed patient or

1 caregiver to possess medical marijuana or medical marijuana
2 products;

3 2. Be accessible to licensed physicians to ensure proper care
4 for patients before medications are prescribed that may interact
5 with the medical use of marijuana; and

6 3. Prevent an active registration of a patient by multiple
7 physicians.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
