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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 954, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 954. It shall be the mandatory duty of the board of
16	county commissioners of any county establishing a retirement fund
17	and system to appropriate annually, for the sole use of the
18	retirement fund within its general fund and subject to the approval
19	of the county excise board, a sum which shall be equal to or exceed
20	the contributions made to the retirement fund by the employees.
21	Such appropriation shall not exceed the sum of the current annual
22	salaries of all employees to be covered in the following
23	percentages:

8	Beginning July 1, 2007 July 1, 2019, the total employer and
9 e	employee contributions shall not exceed sixteen and one-half percent

12 p	participating employers listed in this section may vary the
13 p	percentage contribution of the employer and employee, provided the
14 t	total percentage contributed by the employer and employee equals the

16 s	such shall be paid to the fund upon verified claims by the treasurer
17 0	of said <u>the</u> fund approved by the board of trustees and attested by

19	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
20	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 0	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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1	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
