SENATE BILL NO. 859

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to beef retailers; providing definitions; requiring identification of imported beef for sale to the public; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1150 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

For the purposes of this act:

1. The term "supplier" shall mean any packing company supplying beef for retail sales; and

2. The term "retailer" shall mean any person or entity engaged in the business of selling beef to the public.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1151 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A retailer who sells beef or offers beef for sale shall use a conspicuous placard, that is readily viewable by the public and

1 placed in the immediate vicinity of the beef, to designate and  
2 display the beef as "Imported Beef" if the beef is derived from  
3 animals that were not:

4 1. Born, raised and slaughtered exclusively in the United  
5 States; or

6 2. Born and raised exclusively in the United States and  
7 transported for a period of not more than sixty (60) days through  
8 any other country and slaughtered in the United States.

9 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
