AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to dogs; requiring physical restraint of dogs within a city or town; making it a misdemeanor for violations of this act; providing a fine; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 42.5 of Title 4, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Within any city or town, an owner of a dog shall not permit the dog to be outside of a private enclosure or an enclosed public dog park unless the dog is restrained by a substantial chain or leash and under the physical restraint of a responsible person.

B. Any violator of subsection A of this section, upon conviction, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
