AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 11-705, which relates to the violation and penalty for overtaking a stopped school bus; modifying penalty; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 11-705, is amended to read as follows:

Section 11-705. A. The driver of a vehicle meeting or overtaking a school bus that is stopped to take on or discharge school children, and on which the red loading signals are in operation, is to stop the vehicle before it reaches the school bus and not proceed until the loading signals are deactivated and then proceed past such school bus at a speed which is reasonable and with due caution for the safety of such school children and other occupants. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this subsection shall be punished by a fine of not less than ~~One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)~~ Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

1 B. Visual signals, meeting the requirements of Section 12-228
2 of this title, shall be actuated by the driver of said school bus
3 whenever, but only whenever, such vehicle is stopped on the highway
4 for the purpose of receiving or discharging school children.

5 C. The driver of a vehicle upon a highway with separate
6 roadways need not stop upon meeting or passing a school bus which is
7 on a different roadway or when upon a controlled-access highway and
8 the school bus is stopped in a loading zone which is a part of or
9 adjacent to such highway and where pedestrians are not permitted to
10 cross the roadway.

11 D. If the driver of a school bus witnesses a violation of the
12 provisions of subsection A of this section, within twenty-four (24)
13 hours of the alleged offense, the driver shall report the violation,
14 the vehicle color, license tag number, and the time and place such
15 violation occurred to the law enforcement authority of the
16 municipality where the violation occurred. The law enforcement
17 authority of a municipality shall issue a letter of warning on the
18 alleged violation to the person in whose name the vehicle is
19 registered. The Office of the Attorney General shall provide a form
20 letter to each municipal law enforcement agency in this state for
21 the issuance of the warning provided for in this subsection. Such
22 form letter shall be used by each such law enforcement agency in the
23 exact form provided for by the Office of the Attorney General. A
24 warning letter issued pursuant to this subsection shall not be

1 recorded on the driving record of the person to whom such letter was
2 issued. Issuance of a warning letter pursuant to this section shall
3 not preclude the imposition of other penalties as provided by law.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
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
