AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public finance; establishing that a state employee who creates or possesses appropriated public funds not reported to the Legislature shall be subject to criminal liability; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 53 of Title 62, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any employee of the State of Oklahoma who creates or possesses appropriated public funds which are not reported to the Legislature, or that are not designed for a particular purpose by a federal grant or state statute, shall be subject to criminal liability pursuant to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
