SENATE BILL 97

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S. 2011, Section 21-102, which relates to the Oklahoma Municipal Code; modifying distance of intervening strip considered contiguous to a municipality; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2011, Section 21-102, is amended to read as follows:

Section 21-102. Where any territory to be annexed is separated from the corporate limits of the municipality only by a railway right-of-way, an intervening strip less than ~~four (4)~~ twenty (20) rods wide, or a highway right-of-way, the territory shall be considered adjacent or contiguous to the municipality.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
