18	WHEREAS, the unique medical needs of veterans require a system
19	where veterans can receive care without delay; and
20	WHEREAS, recent negative attention related to delays in care and
21	insufficient staffing throughout the Veterans Affairs (VA) health
22	care system have been a cause for concern throughout the veterans
23	community; and
