14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
15	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
16	The right of Oklahomans to engage in agritourism activities is
17	ingrained in the historical fabric of the State of Oklahoma.
18	Therefore, it is the intent of the Legislature to preserve such
19	activities for future generations of Oklahomans.
20	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-17a of Title 2, unless there
22	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	A. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the rights

of Oklahomans to engage in agritourism activities shall not be

Τ	banned by any country, municipality, state agency of political
2	subdivision. Agritourism activities shall only be engaged in a
3	lawful manner, pursuant to the Oklahoma Horse Racing Act and in
4	compliance with health and safety zoning requirements, as well as
5	health and safety regulations, by the state and local governments.
6	B. "Agritourism activities" as used in this section means
7	utilizing livestock or other animals for entertainment or
8	educational purposes. This shall include horseback riding, horse-
9	drawn carriage rides, livestock and other animal shows, petting
10	farms, rodeos, activities that historically involved the utilization
11	of working animals and other substantially similar activities.
12	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
