Section 27-104. A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Riley Boatwright Act" "Riley's Rule".

B. Prior to the beginning of the 2020-2021 2021-2022 school
year, each school district board of education shall coordinate with
the emergency medical services provider providers that serves serve
the area in which the school district is located to develop a plan
an Emergency Action Plan for the provision of emergency medical
services at each facility and athletic practices, events or
activities held at school district facilities.

15 <u>1. Include maps and directions with appropriate contact</u> 16 <u>information for emergency medical services;</u>

172. Assign a medical administrator who is a current school18employee such as a coach, administrator or athletic director;

21 <u>4. Include a list of medical equipment available and location</u> 22 <u>of the nearest automated external defibrillator, if available;</u>
