23 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the title, enacting clause and the

25 "An Act relating to human trafficking and child
26 exploitation; creating the Advisory Task Force on

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

4 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
5 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

6 A. There is hereby created an Advisory Task Force on Prevention
7 of Human Trafficking and Child Exploitation. There shall be
8 thirteen (13) members on the Advisory Task Force as follows:

9 1. The Cabinet Secretary of Public Safety, or designee;

10 2. The Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation,
11 or a designee;

12 3. The Attorney General, or a designee;

13 4. The Chair of the District Attorneys Council, or a designee;

14 5. The Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and
15 Dangerous Drugs Control, or a designee;

16 6. The Director of the Department of Human Services, or a
17 designee;

18 7. The Executive Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs, or
19 a designee;

20 8. The Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health and
21 Substance Abuse Services, or a designee;

22 9. The Commissioner of the State Department of Health, or a
23 designee;

1 10. The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Association of
2 Chiefs of Police, or a designee;

3 11. The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Sheriffs'
4 Association, or a designee;

5 12. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate, or a designee; and

6 13. The Speaker of the House of Representatives, or a designee.

7 B. The Advisory Task Force shall have the duty to study human
8 trafficking, prostitution and child exploitation in this state. The
9 Advisory Task Force shall make recommendations to the Legislature on
10 methods and laws to enhance and fund the efforts of law enforcement
11 or community groups that are working to slow and stop prostitution,
12 human trafficking or child exploitation; methods to assist in
13 identifying and interrupting websites that promote pornography and
14 sexually explicit materials; and methods that develop and support
15 community groups working with victims to interrupt cycles of abuse
16 or prevent human trafficking, prostitution, sexual abuse or other
17 factors influential in perpetuating human trafficking, prostitution
18 or child exploitation.

19 C. The Advisory Task Force shall have members appointed by
20 August 1, 2021. The Advisory Task Force shall begin meeting and
21 continue studying until January 1, 2022. A report of the findings
22 and recommendations shall be presented to the President Pro Tempore
23 of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the
24

1 Governor on or before February 1, 2022. Upon delivery of the
2 report, the Advisory Task Force shall terminate.

3 D. A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum for the
4 purpose of conducting the business of the Advisory Task Force.

5 E. Members of the Legislature shall receive travel
6 reimbursements from their respective appointing authority in
7 accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

8 F. A Senate member shall call the initial meeting by September
9 1, 2021. The chair of the Advisory Task Force shall be appointed by
10 majority vote of the members.

11 G. Staff of the Senate and House of Representatives shall
12 jointly assist in staffing the Advisory Task Force.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

2 4. The Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and
3 Dangerous Drugs Control, or a designee;

4 5. The Director of the Oklahoma Department of Human Services,
5 or a designee;

6 6. The Executive Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs, or
7 a designee;

8 7. The Commissioner of the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health
9 and Substance Abuse Services, or a designee;

10 8. The Commissioner of the State Department of Health, or a
11 designee;

12 9. The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs
13 of Police, or a designee;
