- C. The selection step required pursuant to subsection A of this section shall be installed and operational no later than January 1, 2021.
- SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
