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11 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause, and  
12 entire bill and insert:  
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14 "An Act relating to the state Medicaid program;  
15 defining term for specific purpose; providing for  
16 codification; providing an effective date; and  
17 declaring an emergency.  
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:  
20 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3241.11 of Title 63, unless  
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:  
23 For the purposes of a federal Medicaid supplemental payment

10 of a county hospital as provided by Section 789 of Title 19 of the  
11 Oklahoma Statutes;

12 3. A municipal governing body that has established and  
13 maintains a municipal hospital as provided by Section 30-101 of  
14 Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 4. A board of control created by and charged by a municipal  
16 governing body with the management and control of a municipal  
17 hospital as provided by Section 30-102 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma  
18 Statutes; and

19 5. Any municipal or governmental body other than the state  
20 authorized to operate a health care facility including a hospital or  
21 nursing facility.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

23 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
24 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3241.11 of Title 63, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

For the purposes of a federal Medicaid supplemental payment  
program for nonstate government owned nursing facilities and  
hospitals, "nonstate government owned" means owned by a government  
other than the state including but not limited to:

1. A board of control created by and charged by a board of  
county commissioners with the management and control of a county  
hospital as provided by Section 789 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma  
Statutes;

2. A public trust or other organization that is created by a  
county under Section 176 of Title 60 of the Oklahoma Statutes and is  
under lease with a board of county commissioners for the operation

1 of a county hospital as provided by Section 789 of Title 19 of the  
2 Oklahoma Statutes;

4 maintains a municipal hospital as provided by Section 30-101 of  
5 Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 4. A board of control created by and charged by a municipal  
7 governing body with the management and control of a municipal  
8 hospital as provided by Section 30-102 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma  
9 Statutes; and

10 5. Any municipal or governmental body other than the state  
11 authorized to operate a health care facility including a hospital or  
12 nursing facility.

13 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

14 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
