16 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause, and entire bill
and insert:
17
18 "An Act relating to alcoholic beverages; amending 37A
19 O.S. 2021, Section 7-102, which relates to
20 cocktails-to-go definitions; expanding the meaning
21 of original container to include manufactured mixed
22 drinks; amending 37A O.S. 2021, Section 7-103, which
relates to the requirements for cocktails-to-go;
23 modifying requirements to sell cocktails-to-go; and
24 providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 37A O.S. 2021, Section 7-102, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 7-102. As used in this act:

1. "Cocktail" or "mixed drink" means any beverage obtained by combining ingredients alcoholic in nature, whether brewed, fermented, or distilled, with ingredients nonalcoholic in nature, such as fruit juice, lemonade, cream or a carbonated beverage;

2. "Single-serve wine" means a bottle or sealed container, containing seven (7) fluid ounces, or less, of wine;

3. "Original container" means, for the purposes of this act only, a container that is filled, sealed and secured with a tamper-evident lid or cap by the original manufacturer of the mixed drink or by a mixed beverage licensee's or caterer licensee's employee at the mixed beverage licensee's or caterer licensee's location ~~with a tamper-evident lid or cap;~~

4. "Sealed container" means a rigid container that contains a mixed drink, is new, has never been used, has a secured lid or cap designed to prevent consumption without removal of the lid or cap and is tamper evident. Sealed container does not include a container with a lid with sipping holes or openings for straws or a container made of plastic, paper or polystyrene foam; and

5. "Tamper evident" means a lid or cap that has been sealed with tamper-evident covers, including, but not limited to, wax dip or heat-shrink wrap.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 37A O.S. 2021, Section 7-103, is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 7-103. A cocktail, mixed drink or single-serve wine
2 ~~placed in a sealed container by a mixed beverage licensee at the~~
3 ~~mixed beverage licensee's or caterer licensee's location in its~~
4 original container may be transferred and sold for off-premises
5 consumption if the following requirements are met:

6 1. The cocktail, mixed beverage or single-serve wine is
7 transferred within the licensed premises by a curbside pickup or by
8 delivery by an employee of the retail licensee who:

9 a. is at least twenty-one (21) years of age, and

10 b. upon delivery, verifies the age of the person to whom
11 the cocktail is being delivered;

12 2. If the employee delivering the cocktail, mixed drink or
13 single-serve wine is not able to safely verify a person's age or
14 level of intoxication upon delivery, the employee shall cancel the
15 sale of alcohol and return the product to the retail license holder;

16 3. The sealed container is placed in the trunk of the vehicle
17 or, if there is no trunk, in the vehicle's rear compartment that is
18 not readily accessible to the passenger area; ~~and~~

19 4. ~~The~~ In the case of a mixed drink sealed by the mixed
20 beverage or caterer licensee, the sealed container shall be affixed
21 with a label or tag that contains the following information:

22 a. the cocktail, mixed drink or single-serve wine
23 ingredients, type and name of the alcohol,
24

- b. the name, license number and address of the mixed beverage licensee or caterer licensee who filled the original container and sold the product,
- c. the volume of the cocktail, mixed drink or single-serve wine in the sealed container, and
- d. verification that the sealed container was filled less than seven (7) days before the date of sale; and

5. In the case of a mixed drink in its original container from the original manufacturer of the mixed drink, the Oklahoma-registered label shall not be tampered with, modified, or otherwise changed.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.7, as
15 amended by Section 5, Chapter 69, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020,
16 Section 1135.7), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1135.7. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission or private
18 vendor with whom the Commission has contracted is authorized to
19 design and issue special license plates to any person that applies
20 to the Tax Commission or private vendor for the creation of a
21 special license plate and meets the minimum standards and
22 qualifications specified in this section.

23 B. If the following standards and guidelines are satisfied, the
24 Tax Commission shall authorize the issuance of a special license

plate to the person making application for the special license plate:

1. The license plate is to:

a. show membership in or affiliation with an organization, or

b. demonstrate support for an organization, group or cause;

2. The license plate does not advertise or endorse a product, brand, or service that is provided for sale;

3. The license plate does not promote any philosophy based on prejudice or that is contrary to state civil rights laws; and

4. Two hundred prepaid applications for the special license plate are received by the Tax Commission or private vendor.

C. The fee for special license plates shall be determined in accordance with Section ~~1 of this act~~ 1135.9 of this title. If the special license plate does not provide financial assistance the fee shall be no less than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise provided in this section, Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) of the fee shall be apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special license plate fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act and the remaining amounts of

1 the special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in
2 Section 1104 of this title.

3 D. For special license plates that provide financial assistance
4 created pursuant to the provisions of this section, the Tax
5 Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement
6 with an organization for any licensing fees that may be required to
7 use the organization's logo or design.

8 E. The fee for special license plates that provide financial
9 assistance shall be determined in accordance with Section ~~1 of this~~
10 ~~act~~ 1135.9 of this title. Provided, the fee shall be no less than
11 Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other
12 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
13 Registration Act. Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) per year of renewal
14 of the fee shall be apportioned as follows:

15 1. a. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be
16 apportioned to the License Plate Special Program
17 Assistance Revolving Fund created in Section 1135.8 of
18 this title to be used in the manner detailed in the
19 application for the special license plate~~r~~, except as
20 provided in subparagraph b of this paragraph.

21 b. If the Tax Commission has entered into a licensing
22 agreement with an organization for the use of its
23 design or logo pursuant to Chapter 74 of Title 47 of
24 the Oklahoma Statutes, an amount to be determined in

1 the licensing agreement, but not to exceed twenty
2 (\$20) dollars per license plate issued, shall be
3 transferred monthly to that organization as payment of
4 licensing fees and no fee shall be apportioned to the
5 License Plate Special Program Assistance Revolving
6 Fund.

7 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
9 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
10 and

11 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
12 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

13 ~~E.—If~~ F. Except as otherwise provided in subsection D and
14 subparagraph b of paragraph 1 of subsection E of this section, if a
15 person applies for a special license plate that provides financial
16 assistance, the application shall designate a state agency to be
17 responsible for expending the funds generated by the special license
18 plate and the application shall designate a specific public purpose
19 for which the funds are to be used. The application shall include
20 an acknowledgment from the designated state agency of their
21 agreement with acceptance of the designated funds.

22 ~~F.~~ G. Special license plates shall not be transferred to any
23 other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
24 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used

1 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
2 registered for the current year.

3 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
4 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
5 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.
6 The Tax Commission shall notify all persons issued special license
7 plates of the renewal procedures prior to the expiration of the
8 special license plate. The notice shall contain all necessary
9 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure
10 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.
11 The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

12 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
13 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
14 applications for special license plates authorized under this
15 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
16 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
17 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
18 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
19 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
20 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
21 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
22 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
23 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

1 ~~G. H.~~ All special plates issued by the Tax Commission prior to
2 ~~the effective date of this act~~ November 1, 2005, shall not be
3 subject to the requirements and qualifications outlined in this
4 section.

5 ~~H. I.~~ As used in this section, "person" includes an individual,
6 group, organization or not-for-profit corporation that is recognized
7 as such by the Internal Revenue Service.

8 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
9 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
10 2020, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

11 Section 1135.5. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
12 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
13 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
14 financial assistance as provided by this section.

15 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
16 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
17 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
18 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
19 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

20 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
21 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
22 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.
23 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special
24 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information

1 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
2 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
3 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

4 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
5 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
6 applications for special license plates authorized under this
7 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
8 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
9 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
10 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
11 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
12 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
13 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
14 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
15 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

16 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
17 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
18 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
19 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
20 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
21 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
22 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
23 removed from the vehicle.

1 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
2 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
3 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
4 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
5 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
6 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
7 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
8 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
9 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

10 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
11 follows:

12 1. University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
14 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
15 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
16 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

17 2. Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
19 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
20 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
21 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
22 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
23 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
24 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination

1 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
2 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
3 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
4 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
5 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
6 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
7 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
8 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

9 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
10 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
11 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
12 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
13 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
14 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
15 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
16 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
17 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
18 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
19 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
20 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
21 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
22 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
23 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
24 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

1 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
2 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
3 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
4 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

5 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
7 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
8 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
9 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
10 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
11 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
12 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
13 plates.

14 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
15 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
16 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

17 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
19 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
20 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
21 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
22 the prevention of child abuse.

23 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
24 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

1 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plate -
2 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
4 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
5 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
6 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
7 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
8 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
9 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
10 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
11 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
12 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
13 issued;

14 7. Oklahoma History License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
16 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
17 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
18 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

19 8. Historic Route 66 License Plate - such:

- 20 a. vehicle plates shall be designed to honor historic
21 Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As
22 provided in this section, an amount of the fee
23 collected for each vehicle license plate shall be
24 apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society

1 Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Route 66
2 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and

3 b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation
4 with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. The
5 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
6 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66
7 Association, Inc., for any licensing fees which may be
8 required in order to use the Oklahoma Route 66
9 Association, Inc., logo or design. The licensing
10 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma
11 Route 66 Association, Inc., of not more than Twenty
12 Dollars (\$20.00) for each motorcycle license plate
13 issued;

14 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
16 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
17 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
18 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
19 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
20 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
23 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
24 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying

1 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
2 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
3 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
4 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
5 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
6 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
7 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
10 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
11 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
12 Revolving Fund;

13 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
14 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
16 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
17 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
18 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
19 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
20 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
21 provide services to crime victims;

22 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The

1 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
2 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
3 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
4 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
5 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

6 14. Four-H Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
7 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
8 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
9 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
10 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
11 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
12 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
13 Section 1104.4 of this title;

14 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
16 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in
17 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
18 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the
19 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount
20 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section
21 1104.3 of this title;

22 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
24 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The

1 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
2 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
3 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
4 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
5 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
6 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

7 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
9 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
10 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
11 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
12 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
13 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
14 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
15 follows:

- 16 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
17 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 18 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
19 Education Revolving Fund,
- 20 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
21 Career Technology Fund, and
- 22 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
23 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
24

1 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes.

3 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
4 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
5 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
6 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
7 paragraph;

8 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plate -
9 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
10 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
11 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
12 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
13 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
14 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
15 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
16 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
17 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
18 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
19 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
20 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
21 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
22 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
23 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
24

1 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
2 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

3 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plate - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued
6 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
7 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
8 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax
9 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a

18 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
19 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
20 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
21 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
22 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
23 of this title;

1 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
3 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
5 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
6 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
7 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
8 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

9 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall
10 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant
11 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and
12 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and
13 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of
14 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be
15 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the
16 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.
17 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited
18 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be
19 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of
20 the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act specifically for

22 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
23 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
24 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

1 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
3 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
4 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
5 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
6 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
7 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
8 Section 1104.8 of this title;

9 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
10 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
11 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
12 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
13 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
14 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
15 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
16 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
17 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
18 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
19 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
20 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
21 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
22 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
23 plate issued;

1 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be
4 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon.
5 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
6 agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon for any licensing
7 fees which may be required in order to use the Oklahoma City
8 Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing agreement shall

4 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
5 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
6 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
7 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
8 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
9 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
10 Section 1104.10 of this title;

11 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
12 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
13 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
14 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
15 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
16 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
17 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
18 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
19 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

20 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
21 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
22 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
23 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
24 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on

1 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
2 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
3 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
4 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
5 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plate -
7 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
8 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
9 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
10 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
11 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
12 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
13 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
14 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
15 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
16 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
17 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
18 plate issued;

19 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
21 the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be designed
22 in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Association. As
23 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be

1 deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving Fund created in
2 Section 1104.12 of this title;

3 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
5 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
6 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates

16 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
17 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this

19 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
20 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
21 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
22 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
23 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
24 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be

1 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
2 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

3 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plate - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
6 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
7 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
8 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
9 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
10 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
11 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
12 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
13 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
14 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
15 each license plate issued;

16 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
17 be authorized to be designed and issued to any person wishing to
18 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Chapter of Folds of Honor
19 Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization exempt from
20 taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, 26
21 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing educational scholarships to
22 spouses and children of America's fallen and disabled military
23 service members. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
24 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six.

1 Such person may apply for a Folds of Honor Supporter license plate

19 for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
20 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
21 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
22 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
23 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
24 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any

1 official logo or design of the organization. The Tax Commission, if
2 necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Downed
3 Bikers Association for any licensing fees which may be required in

13 45th Infantry Division Museum. Persons applying for such license
14 plate must show proof of past military service. As provided in this

19 in order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing
20 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Music Hall of

10 as for personalized plates. The license plate for a motorcycle may
11 be of similar design as space permits or a new design in order to
12 meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The
13 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
14 licensing agreement with ABATE of Oklahoma for any licensing fees
15 which may be required in order to use the ABATE of Oklahoma logo or

17 of having obtained the rank of Eagle Scout. The Oklahoma Tax
18 Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement
19 with the various Oklahoma local councils for any licensing fees
20 which may be required in order to use the applicable logo or design.

11 91. Former Oklahoma Legislator License Plate - such plates
12 shall be designed and issued to any person who previously served as
13 a member of the Oklahoma House of Representatives or Oklahoma State
14 Senate. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
15 the Oklahoma Historical Society. As provided in this section, an
16 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
17 Historical Society Capital Improvement and Operations Revolving Fund
18 created in Section 1.10a of Title 53 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The
19 Tax Commission shall create and maintain a list of former members of
20 the Oklahoma House of Representatives and Oklahoma State Senate
21 eligible to be issued such plates; provided, that no former member
22 of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and Oklahoma State Senate
23 shall be eligible to possess more than two of such plates at any one
24 time. The Tax Commission shall confer as needed with the Chief

11 foundation's logo or design. The plates shall be issued to any
12 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
13 maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. The licensing
14 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Nature Conservancy of
15 Oklahoma of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
16 plate issued;

17 93. Oklahoma Tennis Foundation License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support for the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation. The license plates
20 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Tennis
21 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
22 licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation for any
23 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
24 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide

1 for a payment to the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation of not more than
2 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

3 94. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plate - such plates shall
4 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
5 for the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation. The license plates
6 shall be designed in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars
7 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
8 licensing agreement with the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation for
9 any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
10 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
11 for a payment to the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation of not more
12 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

13 95. Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization License Plate - such
14 plates shall be designed and issued to any female veteran of any
15 branch of the United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate
16 support for the Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization. The license
17 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Women
18 Veterans Organization. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to
19 enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Women Veterans
20 Organization for any licensing fees which may be required in order
21 to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement
22 shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Women Veterans
23 Organization of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
24 license plate issued;

1 96. FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and
2 Technology) License Plate - such plates shall be issued to any
3 person wishing to demonstrate support for FIRST Robotics Programs.
4 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
5 administration of FIRST. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be
6 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with FIRST for any
7 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the FIRST logo
8 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
9 FIRST of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
10 plate issued;

11 97. Pittsburg State University License Plate - such plates
12 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 support for the Pittsburg State University. The license plates
14 shall be designed in consultation with Pittsburg State University.
15 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
16 agreement with Pittsburg State University for any licensing fees
17 which may be required in order to use the school foundation's logo
18 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
19 the Pittsburg State University of not more than Twenty Dollars
20 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; and

21 98. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates
22 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the
23 Historic Greenwood District Juneteenth Festival held in the Historic
24 Greenwood District in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued

1 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
2 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
3 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Black Wall Street
4 Chamber of Commerce. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee
5 collected shall be deposited in the Historic Greenwood
6 District/Juneteenth Festival Revolving Fund established in Section 5
7 ~~of this act~~ 2368.32 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Two
8 Dollars (\$2.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
9 Public School Classroom Support Revolving Fund, for expenditure as
10 provided in Section 1-123 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

11 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
12 (\$35.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
13 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
14 Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as follows:

15 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year of renewal or any other
16 amount as provided in this title of the fee shall be apportioned as
17 provided or deposited in a fund as specified within the paragraph
18 authorizing the special license plate;

19 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall
20 be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
21 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
22 Registration Act; and

23 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
24 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

SECTION 6. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
