14 AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 2, lines 7 through 8, delete the phrase "in a
15 conspicuous location"

16 Page 2, line 8, delete the phrase "each entrance
of"

17 Page 2, line 9, after the period "." and before
18 "The" insert the following language:
19 "Signage shall be located at the perimeter of the
20 property with dimensions measuring no less than
21 eighteen (18) inches by twenty-four (24) inches
22 with a font size of no less than two (2) inches.
23 Information required to be displayed on the sign
24 shall be in black standardized font on a white
background. The Oklahoma Medical Marijuana
Authority shall promulgate rules as necessary
regarding the size, placement, issuance and
specifications of the required signage."

1 Page 2, line 18, insert after the word "signage"
2 and before the word "in" the following language:
3 "within sixty (60) days after the renewal of each
4 application for a medical marijuana commercial
5 grower license".

4 AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 2, line 20, insert after the period "." the
5 following language:
6 "Upon issuance of a temporary license, all medical
7 marijuana commercial grower licensees shall be
8 required to comply with the provisions of this
9 subsection prior to the prelicensure inspection
10 conducted by the Authority."

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[Oklahoma Medical Marijuana and Patient Protection
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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 427.21, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 427.21. A. A medical marijuana business shall not
engage in advertising that is deceptive, false or misleading.

B. Medical marijuana advertising shall not contain any
statement or illustration that:

1. Promotes overconsumption;
2. Represents that the use of marijuana has curative or
therapeutic effects; or
3. Depicts a child or other person under legal age to consume
marijuana, or includes:
 - a. objects such as toys or cartoon or other characters,
which suggest the presence of a child, or any other
depiction designed in any manner to be especially

1 appealing to children or other persons under legal age
2 to consume marijuana, or

3 b. any manner or design that would be especially
4 appealing to children or other persons under eighteen
5 (18) years of age.

6 C. Upon the effective date of this act, all medical marijuana
7 commercial grower licensees shall be required to post signage in a
8 conspicuous location at each entrance of the site of the commercial
9 grow operation. The following information shall be included on the
10 required signage:

- 11 1. Business name;
- 12 2. Physical address of the licensed business;
- 13 3. Phone number of the licensed business; and
- 14 4. Medical marijuana business license number.

15 The required signage shall also comply with county regulations
16 and local ordinances related to the real property where the
17 commercial grow operation is located. Failure to erect the proper
18 signage in accordance with the provisions of this subsection shall
19 result in the immediate revocation of the medical marijuana
20 commercial grower license.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
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
